These deaths don't make sense unless the doctors are being murdered, the target of a particularly clever killer. This time, the FBI wants as little to do with Lucas as he does with them so he's left with only one option—ignore it and go back to his normal life. But then, the pattern reveals that the next victim is likely to be...Erin herself. *Pretio* is a continuation of my previous autobiography, *Love's the Only House*. This book is a diary of the love and loyalty Pretio and I share and his journey with colon cancer. It expounds on my mental breakdowns—due to the aftermath of my first marriage—in order to create awareness of the disease. It also delves into the multiple reunions of myself and my previously estranged sons. Is friendship supposed to feel like walking over the falls?
