Harpsichords with richer and fuller sound were also built later in the 18th century, opening up a variety of possibilities for new repertoire. Later, the two-manual concept was adapted to the piano, and the Moór piano, as well as the hyperpiano, represent a culmination in the evolution of keyboard instruments. With the expansion of the keyboard's capabilities in the two-manual harpsichord, players were able to play technically challenging passages in a close position, as well as give clarity to dynamic contrasts. Composers composed a number of works in response to these innovations, ranging from François Couperin's Pièces de clavecin, J.S.
